10 Traditional Hari Raya Dishes from Around The World

Eid al-Fitr is a significant Islamic festival, also known as the "festival of breaking the fast." It marks the end of Ramadan, a month-long period of fasting and spiritual reflection. 
Rendang Ayam

Rendang ayam is a delicious and popular dish that is often served during the festive season of Raya in Malaysia, Indonesia, and other parts of Southeast Asia. Lemang

Sheer Kurma

Tufahija

Tufahija is a sweet Bosnian dessert enjoyed during Eid. Poached apples are stuffed with walnuts and soaked in sugar, then served in a glass filled with syrup and whipped cream to celebrate the end of fasting.



Nalli Nihari

Nalli Nihari is a popular slow-cooked mutton dish in India made with shank meat of goat or lamb. It takes up to four hours to prepare but is worth it for its flavorful blend of spices. It is also considered a signature dish of Raya, a small town in Uttar Pradesh, India.

Maamoul

Maamoul is an ancient Arab dessert that comes in the form of a dome, ball, or flattened cookie and is filled with ingredients such as dates, walnuts, pistachios, almonds, and figs. It is a popular sweet in countries like Syria and Lebanon.



Lokum

Lokum, commonly referred to as 'Turkish Delights', are bite-sized sugary cubes that are a beloved sweet treat in Turkey. This gel-like dessert is made with a combination of starch, sugar, and various fillings such as dates, pistachios, and walnuts. Lokum comes in different colors and is known for its attractive appearance, making it one of the most visually pleasing Eid sweets.



Bolani

Bolani, a flatbread stuffed with various fillings like spinach, potatoes, pumpkin, or lentils, is a traditional Afghan dish commonly served during Eid. It is one of the few savoury dishes that people enjoy during the festive season, and it can be found on most households' tables in Afghanistan.

Haleem

Haleem is a popular dish in many countries including India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, and the Middle East. It is a ghee-rich lentil and minced meat porridge made with gram moong dal, chana dal, and wheat, and is typically served hot with naan. 


