

PLASTIC CAN BE SUSTAINABLE IF There's a system to recycle and put It back in circulation

- SYED ZAIN ALMOHDZAR -

Syed Zain Almohdzar, CTO of Janz Technologies and a Gen.T x Credit Suisse Social Impact Awards recipient, champions a unique perspective on plastic sustainability in Malaysia. He believes in controlling the circular economy of plastic rather than demonising it, leading to the creation of **Klean—a pioneering reverse vending machine (RVM)**.

Klean incentivises recycling by rewarding users through a mobile app, with 34 machines across the country. So far, Klean has recycled 420,000 containers, saved 37.5 tonnes of carbon emissions, and is poised to help local businesses measure their social impact in sustainability as Malaysia's stock exchange introduces its voluntary carbon exchange market.

Khor Sue Yee, influenced by Lauren Singer's Ted Talk, co-founded Zero Waste Malaysia in 2016. This community, with over 40,000 members, promotes a zero-waste lifestyle. Khor's journey began with small steps and social media documentation.



ASCEND

Zero Waste Malaysia offers valuable resources through its website, including a nationwide map of zero-waste solutions and a trash "encyclopedia." They collaborate with financial institutions for sustainability education, conduct immersive programmes, and deliver talks to drive action, reshaping society's approach to waste reduction.



SYAZWAN MAJID

Syazwan Majid, the force behind Malaysian startup **Arus Oil, is on a mission to combat drain-clogging used cooking oil disposal and reduce Malaysia's reliance on non-renewable energy**. What began as a neighbourhood recycling project has evolved into a thriving initiative that recycles over 250 metric tonnes of used cooking oil into biodiesel.

Arus Oil offers convenient, on-demand collection services to overcome the convenience barrier to recycling. With expansion plans and collection points in multiple states, Syazwan's innovative approach not only tackles environmental issues but also promotes a sustainable energy future through renewable biodiesel.







This choice of material not only adds to the phone's aesthetics but also contributes to its lightweight and durability, extending the device's lifespan.

Apple has taken steps to integrate sustainability into the device's core components. The company has employed 100 percent recycled rare earth elements in all magnets and 100 percent recycled gold in the USB-C connector and circuit boards. 
